

Over 100 bat species eat nectar (~8%)










3 nectar-feeding species in the Southwest US & northern Mexico






















Agaves are critical for

The establishment of seed banks.


The evaluation and monitoring of the condition of the seed.

MILKWEEDS FOR MONARCHS

- •Family: Apocynaceae, Genus: Asclepias
- •73 species of native milkweeds in the U.S.
- •29 species in Arizona >30 in TX
- •Milky latex inside stems
- Source of food for Monarch caterpillars
- •Loss of milkweed habitat throughout the U.S.








